SENATE BILL NO. 184

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Office of the Governor

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to reimburse certain family
2 physicians, midlevel practitioners, and dentists who have complied with the requirements
3 of the physician tuition reimbursement program, the midlevel tuition reimbursement
4 program, or the dental tuition reimbursement program.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

6 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of two hundred seven
7 thousand six hundred fourteen dollars (\$207,614), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to
8 the Department of Health for the purposes of reimbursing three family physicians, two physician
9 assistants, and one dentist who have, in the determination of the department, met the
10 requirements of the state physician tuition reimbursement program established pursuant to § 1-
11 16A-71.1, the midlevel tuition reimbursement program pursuant to § 1-16A-73.6, or the dental
12 tuition reimbursement program established pursuant to § 1-16A-73.20.

13 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Health shall approve vouchers and the state
14 auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
