- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require defendants to perform community service
- 2 restitution when found guilty of vandalism to property in public or private cemeteries.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 34-27 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- Any person who is found guilty pursuant to chapter 22-34 of injuring, damaging, or
- destroying any property in a public or private cemetery shall be ordered by the court to perform
- 8 at least eight hundred hours of community service within two years of the date that the
- 9 sentencing court orders are made. The court services officer assigned to the defendant, shall
- prepare a plan of community service restitution, including the number of work hours to be
- performed, where the community service work is to be performed, and the time necessary for
- 12 completion of the community service work pursuant to chapter 23A-28. The community service
- work shall be performed in a cemetery within a fifty-mile radius of the defendant's home.
