AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to allow certain disabled bow hunters to use special equipment to operate the bow.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 41-8-31 be amended to read as follows:

41-8-31. No person may at any time hunt, catch, take, attempt to take, or kill any small game or game animal in any other manner than by shooting the same with a firearm, except:

- (1) Game birds and animals may be taken with birds trained in falconry or with bow and arrow;
- (2) A disabled person who is missing an upper limb, physically incapable of using an upper limb, or confined to a wheelchair and who has obtained a disabled hunter permit may use a crossbow or other legal bow equipped with a draw-lock device to take game birds and animals; and
- (3) A legally blind person, who is legally licensed, possesses a disabled hunter permit, and is physically present and participates in the hunt but cannot safely discharge a firearm or bow and arrow, may claim game birds and animals taken by a designated hunter in accordance with the license possessed by the legally blind hunter.

A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
