1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to offer a human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination 2 initiative, to transfer funds, and to declare an emergency. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3 4 Section 1. The Department of Health may offer human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine to any 5 woman who is at least eleven years of age and less than nineteen years of age to help protect 6 against the virus that causes cervical cancer at an estimated cost of nine million two hundred 7 thousand dollars. The department may expend up to four hundred thousand dollars of general 8 funds and seven million five hundred thousand dollars of federal fund authority from its fiscal 9 year 2007 budget. 10 Section 2. The Department of Social Services shall transfer one million three hundred 11 thousand dollars of general funds to the Department of Health to provide additional funding for 12 this initiative. 13 Section 3. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its 14 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in 15 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
