- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the procedure for reissuing certain alcoholic
- 2 beverage licenses.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 35-2-1.2 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 35-2-1.2. Any application for a new retail license, except as set forth in § 35-2-1.1, shall be
- 6 submitted to the governing board of the municipality within which the applicant intends to
- 7 operate, or if outside the corporate limits of a municipality, to the board of county
- 8 commissioners of the county in which the applicant seeks to operate. The application shall be
- 9 accompanied by the required fee. The governing board may approve or disapprove the
- application for a new retail license depending on whether the governing board deems the
- applicant a suitable person to hold the license and whether the governing board considers the
- 12 proposed location suitable.
- Any application for the reissuance of a retail license shall be approved by the governing

- board without a hearing unless in the past year the licensee or one or more of the licensee's
- 2 employees have been subjected to a criminal penalty for violation of the alcoholic beverage
- 3 control law or the license has been suspended.
