- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain day care providers to mail notices of
- 2 noncompliance.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 26-6 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 If the Department of Social Services or any other jurisdiction with enforcement authority
- determines that a family day care provider, a group family day care home, or a day care center
- 8 is out of compliance with a license or registration requirement of chapter 26-6 or ARSD Article
- 9 67:42, the provider shall mail a written notice to the parents or legal guardian of each child
- under the provider's care. The written notice shall inform the parent or legal guardian of the
- statute or rule violation, the plan or action to correct the violation, and the penalty that may be
- imposed if the violation is not corrected. The parent or guardian shall sign a notice of receipt
- and return it to the child care provider. The license or registration certificate for the family day
- care provider, the group family day care home, or day care center may be revoked if the family

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1 day care provider, the group family day care home, or day care center fails to mail the written

2 notice to any parent or legal guardian.
