

2021 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 112

1 An Act to establish requirements for filling the vacancies of certain constitutional 2 offices. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3 Section 1. That § 3-4-3 be AMENDED. 4 5 3-4-3. Appointments to fill vacancies--By whom made. 6 All vacancies, except in the office of a member of the Legislature, representative 7 in Congress, and United States Senator, shall be filled by appointment, as follows: 8 (1)The attorney general, secretary of state, state auditor, state treasurer, and 9 commissioner of school and public lands, by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. However, if a vacancy occurs in any of the offices listed in 10 11 this subdivision while the Legislature is in recess, the Governor shall make a 12 temporary appointment until the next session of the Legislature; In other state and district offices, and the Office of Supreme Court Justice and 13 (2) 14 Circuit Judge, by the Governor; 15 (2)(3) In county and precinct offices, by the board of county commissioners, except 16 vacancies on such board; 17 (3)(4) In civil township offices, by the board of supervisors or a majority of them, by 18 warrant under their hands; and if a vacancy occurs from any cause in the foregoing 19 board of appointment the remaining officers of such board shall fill any vacancy 20 therein; and 21 (4)(5) In special purpose districts, unless otherwise provided, by the remaining board of 22 trustees.
