

## 2021 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1184

## 1 An Act to revise provisions on aiding, abetting, or advising.

- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 22-3-3 be AMENDED.

4 22-3-3. Aiding, abetting, or advising--Accountability as principal.
5 Any person who, with the intent to promote or facilitate the commission of a crime,
6 aids, abets, or advises another person in planning or committing the crime, is legally
7 accountable, as a principal to the crime.

8 <u>However, no person who aids, abets, or advises a crime may receive a longer</u> 9 <u>sentence, whether through a conviction or through a plea agreement, than the principal</u> 10 <u>receives for the crime or related crimes derived from the same set of circumstances. This</u> 11 <u>prohibition does not apply to any additional crimes the person committed independent of</u> 12 the principal.

13 **Section 2.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

14 **23A-31-1.1.** Aiding, abetting, or advising--Principal--Sentence--Correction.

- 15 <u>A motion may be brought before the court to correct a sentence for a person</u>
- 16 <u>convicted of aiding, abetting, or advising the principal, whether through a conviction or a</u>
- 17 plea agreement, if the principal received a shorter sentence for that crime than the person,
- 18 in violation of § 22-3-3. The court shall reduce the sentence to comply with § 22-3-3.
