- 1 An Act to remove irreconcilable differences as a cause for divorce.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **Section 1.** That § 25-4-2 be AMENDED.
- 4 **25-4-2.** Grounds for divorce.
- 5 Divorces may be granted for any of the following causes:
- 6 (1) Adultery;
- 7 (2) Extreme cruelty;
- 8 (3) Willful desertion;
- 9 (4) Willful neglect;
- 10 (5) Habitual intemperance; or
- 11 (6) Conviction of felony;
- 12 (7) Irreconcilable differences a crime, resulting in incarceration.
- 13 **Section 2.** That § 25-4-17.1 be REPEALED.
- 14 **25-4-17.1.** Irreconcilable differences defined.
- 15 **Section 3.** That § 25-4-17.2 be REPEALED.
- 25-4-17.2. Dissolution of marriage--Legal separation--Continuance--Orders during continuance--Consent of parties.
- **Section 4.** That \S 25-4-17.3 be REPEALED.
- 19 **25-4-17.3.** Use of affidavits to establish jurisdiction and grounds for divorce.
