Senate Bill 13

Introduced by: The Senate Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of the Military

1 **An Act to authorize the construction of an addition to the BG Dean Mann Readiness**
2 **Center in Sioux Falls, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an**
3 **emergency.**

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 **Section 1.** The Department of the Military may contract for the construction, completion,
6 furnishing, equipping, and maintaining of, including heating, plumbing, water, sewer, electric
7 facilities, architectural and engineering services, and such other services or actions as may
8 be required, to construct an addition to the BG Dean Mann Readiness Center in Sioux Falls
9 for an estimated cost of \$6,000,000, subject to permitted adjustments pursuant to section 3
10 of this Act.

11 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated \$6,000,000 in federal fund expenditure authority to
12 the Department of the Military for the purposes stated in section 1 of this Act.

13 **Section 3.** The Department of the Military may adjust the authorized cost estimate in section
14 1 of this Act to reflect inflation as measured by the Building Cost Index reported by the
15 Engineering News Record, additional expenditures required to comply with regulations
16 adopted after the effective date of this Act, or additional sums received pursuant to section 4
17 of this Act. Any adjustments to the construction cost estimate for the project may not exceed
18 one hundred twenty-five percent of the estimated project construction cost stated in section
19 1 of this Act.

20 **Section 4.** In addition to the amount appropriated in section 2 of this Act, the Department of
21 the Military may accept and expend for the purpose of this Act any funds obtained from gifts,
22 contributions, or any other source, if the acceptance and expenditure is approved in
23 accordance with § 4-8B-10.

1 **Section 5.** The design and construction of this project shall be under the general charge and
2 supervision of the Department of the Military. The adjutant general of the Department of the
3 Military or the state engineer shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants
4 to pay expenditures authorized by section 1 of this Act.

5 **Section 6.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
6 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

7 **Section 7.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
8 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act is in full
9 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
