Senate Bill 126

1 An Act to expand the availability of emergency services in state parks.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 41-15-10.1 be AMENDED:

- 4 41-15-10.1. Any conservation officer, who is certified pursuant to §§ 23-3-39 to 23-3-45, inclusive, or has been appointed on a temporary or probationary basis as permitted by § 23-3-41, shall enforce:

 (1) Enforce every state statute that:
 (1)(a) Which is a crime under Title title 22;
 (2)(b) Which pertains to game, fish, parks, forestry, or boating;
 (3)(c) Which pertains to driving while intoxicated, reckless driving, or eluding an
- 10 (3)(c) Which pertains Pertains to driving while intoxicated, reckless driving, or eluding an officer;
- 12 (4)(d) Which is Is a crime under §§ 35-1-9.1 and or 35-9-2 and occurs on property owned, managed, or leased by the Department of Game, Fish and Parks;
- 14 (5)(e) Which is Is a crime under § 32-5-84.2;
- 15 (6) Which is a crime under § 32-20-6.6;
- 16 $\frac{(7)(f)}{(7)(f)}$ Which is Is a crime under chapter 32-20A; and
- 17 (8)(q) Which is Is a crime under chapter 34A-7; and
- 18 (2) Investigate any accident that involves a vehicle and occurs on property owned,
 19 managed, or leased by the Department of Game, Fish and Parks, and file any report
 20 required in accordance with chapter 32-34.
- While performing any duty pursuant to this section, a conservation officer is a law enforcement officer with the same authority as any other law enforcement officer.

Section 2. That chapter 41-17 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

During the period beginning May fifteenth and ending September thirtieth, the
Department of Game, Fish and Parks shall ensure the availability of twenty-four-hour

emergency services, including dispatch, law enforcement, ambulance, and search and 1 2 rescue services, within the boundaries of each state park. 3 To meet the requirements of this section, the department may employ and train 4 necessary personnel or contract for the provision of the services with: 5 The sheriff of any county in which some or all of the state park is located; or (1) (2) Any other public agency or private entity. 6 7 Nothing in this section removes the obligation of a law enforcement agency to 8 provide services on public highways or private property located within the boundaries of 9 a state park.
