- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require that health benefit plans provide coverage for

- 4 Section 1. That chapter 58-17 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Every policy of health insurance that covers a female, that is delivered, issued for delivery,
- 7 or renewed in this state, and that provides coverage for occult breast cancer screening shall
- 8 provide additional benefits for:
- 9 (1) Comprehensive ultrasound screening of an entire breast or breasts if a mammogram
- demonstrates heterogeneous or dense breast tissue based on the Breast Imaging
- Reporting and Data System established by the American College of Radiology or if
- a woman is believed to be at an increased risk for breast cancer due to family history
- or prior personal history of breast cancer, positive genetic testing, or other indications
- as determined by a woman's physician or advanced practice registered nurse; and
