1	An Act to require that pipeline applicants acquire county permits prior to submission		
2	of a permit application to the Public Utilities Commission.		
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3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:		
4	Section 1. That § 49-41B-11 be AMENDED:		
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5	49-41B-11. All applications <u>An application</u> for a permit-shall <u>must</u> be filed with the		
6	Public Utilities Commission commission, not less than six months prior to the planned date		
7	of <u>the</u> commencement of construction of a facility <u></u> , in such<u>the</u> formas prescribed by rules		
8	promulgated by the commission pursuant to chapter 1-26, and shall must contain , but not		
9	be limited to, the following information:		
10	(1)	The name and address of the applicant;	
11	(2)	DescriptionA description of the nature and location of the facility;	
12	(3)	Estimated The estimated date of commencement of construction and duration of	
13		construction;	
14	(4)	Estimated The estimated number of employees employed at the site of the facility	
15		during the construction phase and during the operating life of the facility. Estimates	
16		shall must include the number of employees who are to be utilized but who do not	
17		currently reside within the area to be affected by the facility;	
18	(5)	FutureAny future additions and modifications to the facility, which the applicant	
19		may wish to be approved in the permit;	
20	(6)	A statement of the reasons for the selection of the proposed location;	
21	(7)	PersonThe name of the person owning the proposed facility and person managing	
22		the proposed facility;	
23	(8)	The purpose of the facility;	
24	(9)	Estimated The estimated consumer demand and estimated future energy needs of	
25		those consumers to be directly served by the facility;

1	(10)	The potential-short and long range short-range and long-range demands on any
2		estimated tax revenues generated by the facility for the extension or expansion of
3		public services within the affected areas;
4	(11)	EnvironmentalAny environmental studies prepared relative to the facility;
5	(12)	Estimated For an applicant proposing construction or operation of a facility or
6		pipeline carrying carbon oxide, a model emergency management plan:
7		(a) Providing emergency pipeline information to each political subdivision, as
8		defined in § 34-48A-1, which may be affected by a rupture of the pipeline;
9		(b) For the development of emergency plans for emergency management
10		required pursuant to § 34-48A-39; and
11		(c) For preparation of the comprehensive plan and program required by the
12		secretary of the Department of Public Safety pursuant to § 34-48A-11;
13	<u>(13)</u>	The estimated construction cost of the facility; and
14	<u>(14)</u>	Any county or municipal land use, zoning, or building rules, regulations,
15		ordinances, or resolutions applicable to the facility, together with all required
16		zoning and land use permits issued by a county or municipality in which the
17		proposed facility is to be located.
