JOINT APPROPRIATIONS ENGROSSED

Introduced by: The Chair of the Senate Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Bureau of Human Resources and Administration

- An Act to provide for the sale of certain real estate located in Pennington County and to provide for the deposit of the proceeds.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** Upon the request of the Governor, the commissioner of school and public lands,
- 5 on behalf of the State of South Dakota, shall sell all or any portion of the following real estate
- 6 and any related personal property and improvements located on the property:
- 7 <u>Certain property generally described as Tract 2 of Tract A in the N2SW4 Less Lot A-1</u>
- 8 located in Section 24 of Township 2 North Range 8 East of the Black Hills Meridian, City of
- 9 Box Elder, Pennington County, South Dakota containing 5.29 acres more or less.
- 10 **Section 2.** Any real estate and related personal property and improvements on the property
- that are generally considered a part of the tracts described in section 1 of this Act, but not
- 12 <u>specifically included in the legal description set out in section 1 of this Act, may be sold as</u>
- provided in this Act as though the property and improvements were specifically described in
- 14 section 1 of this Act.
- 15 **Section 3.** The real estate and other property described in section 1 of this Act must be
- 16 appraised by the Board of Appraisal, as provided in § 5-9-3, and may be sold in any manner
- 17 authorized by law, upon the terms and conditions as the Governor may require, subject to
- 18 <u>any applicable constitutional reservation.</u>
- 19 **Section 4.** The proceeds from the sale of the real estate and other property described in
- 20 <u>section 1 of this Act must be deposited into the federal surplus property fund.</u>
- 21 **Section 5.** The Governor may direct the commissioner of school and public lands to sell any
- 22 real estate and related personal property described in section 1 of this Act to a political
- 23 subdivision within which the real estate and related personal property are located. The sale

- 1 may be made without first offering the real estate and related personal property for sale to
- 2 the public. The sale price must be at least the appraised value as determined by the Board of
- 3 Appraisal, as provided in § 5-9-3, and is subject to any applicable constitutional reservation.
