- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions concerning fees for sponsored
- 2 captive insurance companies.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 58-46-6 be amended to read:
- 5 58-46-6. Each captive insurance company shall pay to the director a nonrefundable fee of
- 6 two thousand dollars for examining, investigating, and processing its application for certificate
- 7 of authority. Two or more captive insurance companies under common ownership or control
- 8 shall pay this fee for each application submitted to the director for a certificate of authority. A
- 9 sponsored captive insurance company shall pay an additional one thousand dollars for every
- 10 additional each protected cell application. However, no additional fee is required for the first
- 11 protected cell application submitted by a sponsored captive insurance company. The director
- may retain legal, financial, and examination services from outside the department. The
- reasonable cost of the services may be charged against the applicant with notice to the applicant.
- 14 The provisions of chapter 58-3 apply to examinations, investigations, and processing conducted
- under the authority of this chapter.
