1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal the South Dakota Board of Geographic Names.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 1-19C-2.1 be repealed.

4 ~~— 1-19C-2.1. The South Dakota Board on Geographic Names is hereby created. The board~~  
5 ~~consists of the secretary of tribal relations and one representative each from the Department of~~  
6 ~~Environment and Natural Resources, the Department of Transportation, the State Historical~~  
7 ~~Society, and the Department of Tourism. The board shall elect a chair and vice chair from~~  
8 ~~among its membership and shall meet at least once each year to consider issues related to~~  
9 ~~geographical place names and to make recommendations to the appropriate local, state, and~~  
10 ~~federal agencies. The board shall investigate any proposed names, solicit public input, and make~~  
11 ~~a recommendation to the United States Board on Geographic Names as to whether the board~~  
12 ~~supports a new or replacement name. The board may establish procedures and standards to~~  
13 ~~recommend, evaluate, and select geographic place names by rules promulgated pursuant to~~  
14 ~~chapter 1-26. The rules shall be compatible with the standards of the United States Board on~~
