1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding resident fishing
2 possession limits.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 41-6-2 be amended to read:

5 41-6-2. A resident of this state may hunt or take in a lawful manner fox squirrel, grey
6 squirrel, red squirrel, cottontail rabbit, game birds, or fish during an open season on land or
7 waters on land owned or leased by the resident without first securing a license to do so.
8 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, a resident is not in violation of any season, daily,
9 or possession limit established for the species of fish in waters on land owned by the resident
10 provided the resident owns the water body in its entirety, and the fish taken remain on the
11 resident's land, unless said body of water has been stocked or managed by the Department of
12 Game, Fish and Parks within the past five years.
