- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the need for a driver
- 2 license or permit to operate certain motor vehicles.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 32-20-2 be amended to read:
- 5 32-20-2. No person may operate a motorcycle, except a moped as defined in § 32-20-1-or,
- a licensed all-terrain vehicle as provided by under § 32-20-13, or any motor vehicle that has
- 7 three wheels and is operated with a steering wheel and foot controls on the public streets or
- 8 highways without a motor vehicle driver's driver license or permit upon which a state testing
- 9 officer has certified that such person is qualified to operate such motorcycle. However, the An
- operator of a moped-or, a licensed all-terrain vehicle, or a motor vehicle that has three wheels
- and is operated with a steering wheel and foot controls shall have a valid motor vehicle
- 12 operator's driver license or permit. The department may waive the testing requirements upon
- completion of a motorcycle safety course approved pursuant to § 32-20-14. A violation of this
