## HOUSE BILL NO. 1132

Introduced by: Representatives Goodwin, Dennert, DiSanto, Frye-Mueller, Howard,  
Jamison, Kaiser, and Pischke and Senators Nelson and Jensen (Phil)

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the minimum age requirements for the  
2 consumption of alcoholic beverages by certain active duty members of the military.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 35-9 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a licensee under this title, or any  
6 employee of the licensee, may sell or furnish alcoholic beverages for consumption on the  
7 premises of a bar or restaurant to a person who:

8 (1) Is at least eighteen years old;

9 (2) Is an active duty, reserve or National Guard service member of the armed forces of  
10 the United States; and

11 (3) At the time the alcoholic beverage is sold or furnished, displays a valid armed forces  
12 identification card issued to the person by the United States Department of Defense.
