- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit certain extractive activities in the Black Hills.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 4 No mining for the purpose of extracting minerals, drilling for the purpose of exploring for
- 5 minerals or resources, fracking, or any other extraction method may occur within the boundaries
- of the Black Hills, unless consent is given, by resolution, by each of the federally recognized
- 7 Indian Tribes in the State of South Dakota.
