## HOUSE BILL NO. 1029

Introduced by: The Committee on Judiciary at the request of the Department of Social Services

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding criminal background  
2 checks for adults working in child care institutions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 26-6-14.4 be amended to read:

5 26-6-14.4. In addition to the applicant, §§ 26-6-14.3 to 26-6-14.7, inclusive, shall be  
6 applicable to the criminal convictions conviction of the following persons:

7 ~~—(1)—Adults responsible for administration or direct supervision of staff;~~

8 ~~—(2)—Any adult residing in the facility;~~

9 ~~—(3)—Any adult, including a volunteer, who provides care and supervision to the children.~~

10 ~~—However, §§ 26-6-14.3 to 26-6-14.7, inclusive, do not apply to adult volunteers or adult staff~~  
11 ~~employed by the applicant on an intermittent basis for less than ten days per month, if such~~  
12 ~~adults are under constant supervision by adults who meet the requirements of §§ 26-6-14.3 to~~  
13 ~~26-6-14.7, inclusive~~ any adult working in a child care institution, including a group home,  
14 residential treatment center, intensive residential treatment center, or shelter care facility.

15 Section 2. That § 26-6-14.13 be amended to read:



1        26-6-14.13. Information obtained from another state's child abuse and neglect central  
2 registry or from the national crime information databases for the purpose of conducting a  
3 background check under § 26-6-14.5 or for approval of a foster or adoptive placement may be  
4 used for purposes related to conducting the background check only and ~~cannot~~ may not be  
5 released except as authorized by law.
