- 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Supporting the Governor's efforts to fuel the state fleet with
- 2 premium E-30 fuel.
- 3 WHEREAS, auto owners report better performance when fueling with premium E-30,
- 4 including better than or equivalent mileage per gallon and greater power; and
- 5 WHEREAS, these reports have been validated in studies like the E-30 Challenge conducted
- 6 by Glacial Lakes Energy; and
- 7 WHEREAS, thousands of owners save money daily fueling with premium E-30; and
- 8 WHEREAS, premium E-30 reduces harmful emissions leading to cleaner air quality; and
- 9 WHEREAS, farmers and ethanol producers are the backbone for many rural economies in
- 10 South Dakota; and
- 11 WHEREAS, premium E-30 is better for vehicle performance, rural economies, the
- 12 American economy, the environment, and public health; and
- 13 WHEREAS, South Dakota has an opportunity to be a regional leader in the promotion of
- 14 our homegrown premium fuel; and



WHEREAS, Governor Noem in her State of the State address noted that the process of
transitioning the state vehicle fleet to the use of premium E-30 fuel has begun:
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the NinetyFourth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the
Legislature supports the Governor in all her efforts to fuel the state fleet with premium E-30 fuel
and to promote our homegrown premium E-30 fuel.
