## HOUSE BILL NO. 1151

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to permit certain acts at a school honoring or graduation  
2 ceremony.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-1-66 be amended to read:

5 13-1-66. The state, any of its political subdivisions, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof  
6 ~~shall~~ of municipalities may not prohibit any person from wearing traditional tribal regalia or  
7 objects of cultural significance or from the singing of an honor song at a school honoring or  
8 graduation ceremony. For purposes of this section the term, tribal regalia or object of cultural  
9 significance, means an eagle feather ~~or,~~ an eagle plume, or a beaded graduation cap.
