1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding criminal background 2 checks for adults working in child care institutions. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 26-6-14.4 be amended to read: 5 26-6-14.4. In addition to the applicant, §§ 26-6-14.3 to 26-6-14.7, inclusive, shall be 6 applicable to the criminal convictions conviction of the following persons: 7 (1) Adults responsible for administration or direct supervision of staff; 8 (2) Any adult residing in the facility; 9 (3) Any adult, including a volunteer, who provides care and supervision to the children; 10 and 11 (4) Any adult working in a child care institution, including a group home, residential 12 treatment center, intensive residential treatment center, or shelter care facility. A 13 child care institution does not include a day care center, group family day care home, 14 or a before and after school day care program.

- 2 employed by the applicant on an intermittent basis for less than ten days per month, if such
- 3 adults are under constant supervision by adults who meet the requirements of §§ 26-6-14.3 to
- 4 26-6-14.7, inclusive.
- 5 Section 2. That § 26-6-14.13 be amended to read:
- 6 26-6-14.13. Information obtained from another state's child abuse and neglect central
- 7 registry or from the national crime information databases for the purpose of conducting a
- 8 background check <u>under § 26-6-14.5 or</u> for approval of a foster or adoptive placement may be
- 9 used for purposes related to conducting the background check only and cannot may not be
- 10 released except as authorized by law.
