- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for state employee protection from retaliation
- 2 for certain communications.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 3-16 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 An employee of the state may not be discharged, disciplined, threatened, or otherwise
- 6 retaliated against regarding the employee's compensation, terms, conditions, location, or
- 7 privileges of employment because the employee communicated information that the employee
- 8 believes, in good faith, to be truthful or accurate related to local or state services, including the
- 9 financing of local or state services, to a legislator or legislative auditor, or to a constitutional
- 10 officer.
