1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide a definition of blockchain technology for certain
2 purposes.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 53-12-1 be amended to read:

5 53-12-1. Terms used in this chapter mean:

- 6 (1) "Agreement," the bargain of the parties in fact, as found in their language or inferred
7 from other circumstances and from rules and procedures given the effect of
8 agreements under laws otherwise applicable to a particular transaction;
- 9 (2) "Automated transaction," a transaction conducted or performed, in whole or in part,
10 by electronic means or electronic records, in which the acts or records of one or both
11 parties are not reviewed by an individual in the ordinary course in forming a contract,
12 performing under an existing contract, or fulfilling an obligation required by the
13 transaction;
- 14 (3) "Blockchain technology," technology that uses a distributed, shared, and replicated
15 ledger, either public or private, with or without permission, or driven with or without



1 tokenized crypto economics where the data on the ledger is protected with
2 cryptography and is immutable and auditable;

3 (4) "Computer program," a set of statements or instructions to be used directly or
4 indirectly in an information processing system in order to bring about a certain result;

5 (4)(5) "Contract," the total legal obligation resulting from the parties' agreement as affected
6 by this chapter and other applicable law;

7 (5)(6) "Electronic," any technology, including blockchain technology, using electrical,
8 digital, magnetic, wireless, optical, electromagnetic, or similar capabilities;

9 (6)(7) "Electronic agent," a computer program or an electronic or other automated means
10 used independently to initiate an action or respond to electronic records or
11 performances in whole or in part, without review or action by an individual;

12 (7)(8) "Electronic record," a record created, generated, sent, communicated, received, or
13 stored by electronic means. The term includes a record that is secured through
14 blockchain technology;

15 (8)(9) "Electronic signature," an electronic sound, symbol, or process attached to or
16 logically associated with a record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent
17 to sign the record. The term includes a signature that is secured through blockchain
18 technology;

19 (9)(10) "Governmental agency," an executive, legislative, or judicial agency,
20 department, board, commission, authority, institution, or instrumentality of the
21 federal government or of a state or of a county, municipality, or other political
22 subdivision of a state;

23 (10)(11) "Information," data, text, images, sounds, codes, computer programs, software,
24 databases, or the like;
