HOUSE BILL NO. 1254

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make appropriations from the water and environment
2 fund and its revolving fund subfunds for various water and environmental purposes and to
3 declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
6 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60, the sum of ten million five hundred thousand dollars
7 (\$10,500,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Board of Water and Natural
8 Resources for the purpose of providing grants and loans to project sponsors under the
9 consolidated water facilities construction program established pursuant to § 46A-1-63.1. Funds
10 shall be provided according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and
11 Natural Resources.

12 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund
13 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60, the sum of two million four hundred thousand dollars
14 (\$2,400,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Board of Water and Natural
15 Resources for the purpose of providing grants and loans to project sponsors under the solid



1 waste management program established pursuant to § 46A-1-83. Funds shall be provided
2 according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

3 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
4 deposited in the state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund established
5 pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000), or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the purpose of providing
7 water quality grants under the state water pollution control revolving fund program established
8 pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds shall be provided according to terms and conditions established
9 by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

10 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
11 deposited in the state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund established
12 pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000), or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the purpose of
14 contracting for the preparation of applications and administration of clean water state revolving
15 fund loans under the state water pollution control revolving fund program established pursuant
16 to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds shall be provided according to terms and conditions established by the
17 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

18 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
19 deposited in the state drinking water revolving fund program subfund established pursuant to
20 § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), or so much thereof as may be
21 necessary, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the purpose of providing small
22 system technical assistance grants and contracting for the preparation of applications and
23 administration of drinking water state revolving fund loans under the state drinking water
24 revolving fund program established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds shall be provided

1 according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

2 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees
3 deposited in the state drinking water revolving fund program subfund established pursuant to
4 § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000), or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the purpose of providing grants
6 to very small community water systems to address drinking water compliance and public health
7 issues. Funds shall be provided according to terms and conditions established by the Board of
8 Water and Natural Resources.

9 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from federal funds deposited in the state drinking
10 water revolving fund program subfund established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of one
11 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Board
12 of Water and Natural Resources for the purpose of providing small system technical assistance
13 set-aside grants to project sponsors under the state drinking water revolving fund program
14 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds shall be provided according to terms and conditions
15 established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

16 Section 8. The secretary of environment and natural resources shall approve vouchers and
17 the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

18 Section 9. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
19 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

20 Section 10. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
21 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
22 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
