1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to create the Special Education Task Force. 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3 Section 1. That chapter 2-6 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read: 4 There is hereby created the Special Education Interim Legislative Committee. The purpose of the interim committee is: 5 6 (1) To examine the diagnostic tools and assessments used to identify students in South 7 Dakota schools in need of special education or special education and related services; (2) To examine the disability categories that are rising at the greatest rate and review 8 9 eligibility requirements; 10 (3) To review the funding levels of the disability categories; 11 (4) To examine the common costs associated with extraordinary cost fund applications, 12 including out-of-district placements; and 13 (5) To develop recommendations to address the increasing costs of services.
