House Bill 1039

Introduced by: The Committee on Commerce and Energy at the request of the Bureau of Human Resources

- An Act to revise the rule-making authority of the Human Resources Commissioner regarding the drug screening program for certain state employees.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** That § 3-6F-5 be AMENDED:
- 5 **3-6F-5. Promulgation of rules.**
- The human resources commissioner may promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, necessary to carry out the provisions of this chapter with regard to:
 - (1) Listing of positions whose primary duty includes patient or resident care or supervision; safety-sensitive positions; and positions at the Department of Agriculture, Division of Wildland Fire, whose duties include firefighting;
- 11 (2) Substances to be screened;

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- 12 (3) Drug screening procedures;
- 13 (4) Procedures for collecting, analyzing, and evaluating test samples;
- 14 (5) Confidentiality of testing procedures;
- 15 (6) Referral for education or treatment; and
- 16 (7) Consequences that may result from valid positive test results or from failure to submit to a test.
