- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain taxes on telegraph companies.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 10-34-1 be repealed.
- 4 10-34-1. Any person owning or operating any telegraph line in this state, with appliances for
- 5 the transmission of messages and engaged in the business of furnishing telegraph service for
- 6 compensation, as owner, lessee, or otherwise, shall be deemed, held, and known as a telegraph
- 7 company.
- 8 Section 2. That §§ 10-34-2 to 10-34-16, inclusive, be repealed.
