- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the municipal bid limits.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 5-18-18 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 5-18-18. The provisions of §§ 5-18-1 to 5-18-17, inclusive, may not be construed to regulate
- 5 or apply to contracts entered into and purchases made by the Department of Transportation or
- 6 by the Bureau of Administration or to the purchase of electric power, light, water, or gas; or any
- 7 municipal corporation for the purchase of materials, supplies, or equipment for any utility owned
- 8 or operated by such municipal corporation, provided that such purchase may not exceed the sum
- 9 of eleven thousand dollars the limits established pursuant to § 5-18-3; or to contracts of any
- municipal corporation in time of war to acquire, establish, construct, own, control, lease, equip,
- improve, maintain, operate, or regulate an airport or landing field for the use of airplanes or other
- aircraft, of the United States armed forces or its members, students, and mechanics; or to
- contracts of any public corporation for the purchase of materials, supplies, or equipment from
- the United States or its agencies; or to equipment repair contracts; or to the purchase of surplus
- property from another public corporation; or to the purchase by one local government entity

- 1 from the lowest responsible bidder of an item competitively bid in the previous twelve months
- 2 by itself or another local government entity or the state at the bid price or less; or to animals
- 3 purchased by a municipality for a zoo.
