- 7 regular stated pay day for which those hours would have normally been paid or as soon
- 8 thereafter as the employee returns to the employer all property of the employer in the employee's
- 9 possession.
- Section 2. That § 60-11-11 be amended to read as follows:
- 11 60-11-11. Whenever an employee not having a written contract for a definite period quits
- or resigns his that employment, the wages or compensation earned shall become are due and
- payable not later than the next regular stated pay day for which those hours would have normally
- been paid or as soon thereafter as the employee returns to the employer all property of the
- employer in the employee's possession.
