- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the use of the municipal sales tax for certain
- 2 street rehabilitation and reconstruction.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 10-52-2 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 10-52-2. Any incorporated municipality within this state may impose any non-ad valorem tax
- 6 in accordance with the provisions of this chapter, except upon fuel used for motor vehicles, by
- 7 ordinance enacted by its local governing board. However, no tax may be levied on the sale, use,
- 8 storage and consumption of items taxed under chapters 10-45 and 10-46, unless such tax
- 9 conforms in all respects to the state tax on such items with the exception of the rate, and the rate
- 10 levied does not exceed two percent.
- If a municipality increases its tax rate above one percent, the revenue generated from the tax
- increase may only be used for capital improvement, to include lease-purchase agreements of
- 13 realty, land acquisition, the funding of public ambulances and medical emergency response
- vehicles, public hospitals, or nonprofit hospitals with fifty or fewer licensed beds, and other

- 1 public health care facilities or nonprofit health care facilities with fifty or fewer licensed beds,
- 2 the transfer to the special 911 fund authorized by § 34-45-12, the purchasing of fire fighting
- 3 vehicles and equipment, and debt retirement and the minor rehabilitation, major rehabilitation,
- 4 or reconstruction of streets as defined in the June, 1994, South Dakota Department of
- 5 Transportation Pavement Condition Survey Guide for City Streets.
