

AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to provide a safety zone for child victims of sex crimes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. The court, upon the conviction of any person of a violation of the provisions of chapter 22-22 in which the victim was a child or upon an adjudication of a juvenile as a delinquent child for a violation of the provisions of chapter 22-22 in which the victim was a child, may, as a part of the sentence or adjudication, order that the defendant or delinquent child not:

- (1) Reside within one mile of the victim's residence unless the person is residing in a juvenile detention facility, jail, or state corrections facility;
- (2) Knowingly or willfully come within one thousand feet of the victim;
- (3) Attend the same school as the victim; or
- (4) Have any contact with the victim, whether direct or indirect or through a third party.

This section does not apply once the victim attains the age of majority. A violation of this section is a Class 6 felony.
