- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the number of days that a temporary snowmobile
- 2 license permit is valid.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 32-6C-10 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 32-6C-10. In the case of If a snowmobile which is sold by a licensed dealer, the dealer may
- 6 provide a temporary fifteen-day thirty-day license permit which is a permit to operate the
- 7 snowmobile in this state for a period of fifteen thirty days after the date of sale or until the time
- 8 the purchaser receives his the regular license decals from the county treasurer, whichever occurs
- 9 first.
