- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide that any person who has lost hunting, fishing, or 2 trapping privileges in another jurisdiction may not exercise that same privilege in South 3 Dakota while under revocation. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 5 Section 1. That chapter 41-6 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 6 follows: 7 Any person who has had hunting, fishing, or trapping privileges revoked or suspended in any 8 other state or country may not purchase a license for or exercise that same privilege in this state 9 during the period of revocation or suspension. Any hunting, fishing, or trapping license applicant 10 shall furnish any information of a revocation or suspension at the time of application. A violation 11 of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
- Section 2. The effective date of this Act is January 1, 1999.
