1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish a holiday to observe the ratification of the Bill
2 of Rights.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 1-5 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 The fifteenth day of December, to be known as Bill of Rights Day, shall be observed in this
7 state as a working holiday. Bill of Rights Day is dedicated to remembrance of and reflection on
8 the ratification of the first ten amendments to the United States Constitution and their
9 significance for all Americans.
