- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for scholarships for certain persons receiving
- 2 workers' compensation benefits.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 62-4 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Scholarships shall be provided for the spouses and dependent children of employees who die
- 7 as a result of compensable work-related injuries if the dependents are entitled to benefits
- 8 pursuant to this chapter. Scholarships are payable to accredited postsecondary education
- 9 institutions in South Dakota on behalf of the dependent students attending the institutions.
- 10 Eligible dependents may qualify for a maximum of two thousand dollars per year, while attending
- a postsecondary education institution. No student may receive assistance pursuant to this Act
- for more than five years. The secretary of the Department of Labor shall promulgate rules,
- pursuant to chapter 1-26, to implement this Act.
