- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize certain uses of money in a school district's
- 2 special education fund.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-37-16 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 13-37-16. For taxes payable in 1997, and each year thereafter, the school board shall levy
- 6 no more than one dollar and forty cents per thousand dollars of taxable valuation, as a special
- 7 levy in addition to all other levies authorized by law for the amount so determined to be
- 8 necessary, and such levy shall be spread against all of the taxable property of the district. The
- 9 proceeds derived from such levy shall constitute a school district special education fund of the
- district for the payment of costs for the special education of all children in need of special
- education or special education and related services who reside within the district pursuant to the
- provisions of §§ 13-37-8.2 to 13-37-8.10, inclusive. The levy in this section shall be based on
- valuations such that the median level of assessment represents 85% of market value as
- determined by the Department of Revenue. The total amount of taxes that would be generated
- at the levy pursuant to this section shall be considered local effort. Money in the special
- education fund may be expended for the purchase or lease of any real property, plant, or

1 equipment that is directly related to special education.
