1	FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to clarify the employment status of certain election workers		
2	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:		
3	Section 1. That § 61-1-10.4 be amended to read as follows:		
4	61-1-10.4. For the purposes of §§ 61-1-10.2 and 61-1-10.3 the term, "employment",		
5	does not apply to service performed:		
6	(1)	In the employ of:	
7		(a) A church or convention or association of churches, or	
8		(b) An organization which is operated primarily for religious purposes and which	
9		is operated, supervised, controlled, or principally supported by a church or	
10		convention or association of churches; or	
11	(2)	By a duly ordained, commissioned, or licensed minister of a church in the exercise of	
12		his ministry duties required by the church or by a member of a religious order in the	
13		exercise of duties required by such the order; or	
14	(3)	In the employ of a school which is not an institution of higher education prior to	
15		January 1, 1978; or in the employ of a governmental entity referred to in § 61-1-10.2

1		after December 31, 1977, if such the service is performed by an individual in the
2		exercise of duties:
3		(a) As an elected official;
4		(b) As a member of a legislative body, or a member of the judiciary, of a state or
5		political subdivision;
6		(c) As a member of the state national guard or air national guard;
7		(d) As an employee serving on a temporary basis in case of fire, storm, snow,
8		earthquake, flood, or similar emergency;
9		(e) In a position which, under or pursuant to the laws of this state, is designated
10		as a major nontenured policymaking or advisory position, or a policymaking
11		position the performance of the duties of which ordinarily does not require
12		more than eight hours per week; or
13		(f) As a precinct election official or automatic tabulating system worker if the
14		amount of remuneration received by the individual during the calendar year for
15		services as a precinct election official or automatic tabulating system worker
16		is less than one thousand dollars; or
17	(4)	In a facility conducted for the purpose of carrying out a program of rehabilitation for
18		individuals any individual whose earning capacity is impaired by age or physical or
19		mental deficiency or injury or providing remunerative work for individuals any
20		individual who because of their impaired physical or mental capacity cannot be readily
21		absorbed in the competitive labor market by an individual receiving such rehabilitation
22		or remunerative work; or
23	(5)	As part of an unemployment work-relief or work-training program assisted or
24		financed in whole or in part by any federal agency or an agency of a state or political
25		subdivision-thereof, by an individual receiving such work relief or work training; or
