## SENATE BILL NO. 84

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize sheriffs to collect fees for expenses incurred
- 2 in executing court orders.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 7-12 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- Any sheriff may collect fees to recover reasonable expenses that are incurred as a result of
- 7 executing an order of the court. The party who initiated the court action shall pay the fees and
- 8 may pursue any available judicial remedy to recover such costs from the other parties involved
- 9 in the action. The party who initiated the court action may appeal to the judge who issued the
- order for a reduction or waiver of all fees based upon ability to pay or reasonableness of
- 11 expenses.
