## HOUSE BILL NO. 1185

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit discrimination against certain employees for
- 2 nonattendance due to severe weather or road conditions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 60-4 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 It is a discriminatory and unfair employment practice for an employer to terminate, penalize,
- 7 or discipline an employee who chooses not to travel to work if a state or local law enforcement
- 8 agency has publicly recommended that there be no nonessential travel at the time in that area due
- 9 to severe weather or road conditions. The provisions of this section do not apply to any
- 10 employee whose job is necessary to the public peace, health, or safety under the existing
- circumstances. However, an employer may require any employee to make a reasonable effort to
- 12 notify the employer that the employee has chosen not to travel to work in response to a state or
- local law enforcement agency's public recommendation that there be no nonessential travel.
