1	FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to restrict the access of minors to obscene materials or
2	certain public access computers and to limit liability for certain related actions.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
4	Section 1. Any public school that provides a public access computer shall equip the compute
5	with software that will prevent minors from gaining access to obscene materials or purchase
6	internet connectivity from an internet service provider that provides filter services to limit access
7	to obscene materials.
8	Section 2. Any public library that provides a public access computer shall do one or both o
9	the following:
10	(1) Equip the computer with software that will limit minor's ability to gain access to
11	obscene materials or purchase internet connectivity from an internet service provide
12	that provides filter services to limit access to obscene materials;
13	(2) Develop and implement by January 1, 2001, a policy that establishes measures to
14	restrict minors from gaining computer access to obscene materials.
15	Section 3. Any public school that complies with section 1 of this Act or any public library
16	that complies with section 2 of this Act may not be held liable for any damages that may arise
17	from a minor gaining access to obscene materials through the use of a public access compute

- 1 that is owned or controlled by the public school or public library.
- 2 Section 4. For the purposes of this Act, obscene material is defined pursuant to subdivision
- 3 22-24-27(11).
- 4 Section 5. For the purposes of this Act, a public access computer is any computer that:
- 5 (1) Is located in a public school or public library;
- 6 (2) Is frequently or regularly used directly by a minor; and
- 7 (3) Is connected to any computer communication system.
