1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase the maximum amount allowable for the livestock 2 ownership inspection fee. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3 4 Section 1. That § 40-18-16 be amended to read as follows: 5 40-18-16. The board may promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 to: (1) Describe prohibited brand symbols for various types of livestock and identify locations 6 7 on animals where a brand is permitted; 8 (2) Provide for the registration, transfer, and renewal of livestock brands; (3) Establish a brand registration fee not to exceed twenty-five dollars; 10 (4) Establish a brand renewal fee not to exceed five dollars per year or a brand renewal 11 fee not to exceed twenty-five dollars for each five-year ownership period and a brand 12 transfer fee not to exceed twenty-five dollars; 13 (5) Establish an ownership inspection fee not to exceed sixty eighty cents for each head 14 of livestock: 15 Establish recordable livestock brands; (6) 16 (7) Establish law enforcement, ownership inspection, and transportation requirements
