That chapter 60-2 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 5 follows: 6 It is an unlawful employment practice for an employer to seek to obtain, to obtain, or to use 7 genetic information, as defined in section 2 of this Act, of an employee or a prospective 8 employee to distinguish between or discriminate against employees or prospective employees or 9 restrict any right or benefit otherwise due or available to an employee or a prospective employee. 10 Any employee or prospective employee claiming to be aggrieved by this unlawful employment 11 practice may bring a civil suit for damages in circuit court. The court may award reasonable 12 attorney fees and costs in addition to any judgment awarded to the employee or prospective
