- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide notice to schools if a student commits a crime
- 2 of violence.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. Within ten days after disposition of any judicial proceeding in which a juvenile is
- 5 adjudicated or convicted of an offense, which constitutes a crime of violence as defined in
- 6 subdivision 22-1-2(9), the Unified Judicial System shall give notice to the chief administrator of
- 7 the school in which the juvenile is enrolled. The notice shall include a description of the offense
- 8 committed, the acts constituting the offense, and the disposition by the court. The school
- 9 administrator may not disclose this information to the public.
