## SENATE BILL NO. 25

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require the use of safety seat belts by passenger vehicle 2 occupants under eighteen years of age. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That chapter 32-37 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 5 follows: 6 The operator of any passenger vehicle transporting a child who is at least five and under 7 eighteen years of age on the streets and highways of this state shall assure that the child is 8 wearing a properly adjusted and fastened safety seat belt system at all times when the vehicle is 9 in motion. A violation of this section is a petty offense. 10 Section 2. That chapter 32-37 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 11 follows: 12 The operator and every passenger of any passenger vehicle operated on a public street or 13 highway in this state, who is at least fourteen and under eighteen years of age, shall wear a 14 properly adjusted and fastened safety seat belt system at all times when the vehicle is in motion.

A violation of this section is a petty offense.

- 2 32-37-2. The provisions of § 32-37-1 this chapter do not apply:
- 3 (1) If all seating positions equipped with seat belts are occupied; or
- 4 (2) In in passenger cars manufactured before 1966 that have not been equipped with seat
- 5 belts.
