1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain state vehicles to use ethanol or biodiesel
2 blend.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. Each motor vehicle owned or leased by the state shall be fueled with ethanol blend
5 or biodiesel blend fuel if it is available. Each state-owned fuel terminal or facility for fueling state
6 vehicles shall provide a supply of ethanol blend or biodiesel blend fuel in quantities sufficient to
7 meet normal fueling needs at the terminal or facility.

8 Section 2. That § 10-47B-3 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SUBDIVISION to read
9 as follows:

10 "Biodiesel blend," a blended motor fuel containing a minimum of two percent by volume of
11 biodiesel fuel. Biodiesel fuel oil is a biodegradable, combustible liquid fuel derived from
12 vegetable oils or animal fats that is suitable for blending with diesel fuel oil for use in internal
13 combustion diesel engines.
