- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish a program for teacher mentors.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. There is hereby created a program to provide for mentor teachers in South Dakota
- 4 school districts which elect to participate. The South Dakota Board of Education shall
- 5 promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, to establish duties and qualifications for teachers to
- 6 be designated as mentor teachers. Participation in the program is discretionary with each school
- 7 district according to a mentor teacher plan adopted by the school board for the school district.
