1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to eliminate the requirement that appointed scale inspectors
2 take an oath of office and post a performance bond.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 37-22-5 be amended to read as follows:

5 37-22-5. The Division of Commercial Inspection and Regulation ~~of this state is hereby~~
6 ~~authorized and empowered to~~ may appoint suitable and competent inspectors to aid the said
7 division in making inspections and repairs of scales under its jurisdiction, ~~such appointments to~~
8 ~~be made for such time as the.~~ The division shall designate the length of any appointment. Each
9 person so appointed shall qualify by taking an oath of office and giving a bond to the state in the
10 ~~sum of one thousand dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties. Such~~
11 ~~inspectors~~ inspector shall report to the division at ~~such~~ the time or times and in ~~such~~ the manner
12 as the ~~said~~ division may require.
